

Announcement of Nanongthoom Subdistrict Municipality on not accepting any kind of gifts for the performance of duties (No Gift Policy) Fiscal Year 2024

According to the Organic Act on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption (2018), Section 128, paragraph one, which states "No government official is allowed to receive property or any other benefits, which may be calculated as income from anyone apart from property or any other benefits in accordance with the principles of ethics and the amount specified by the NACC". Together with the Civil Service Code of Ethics, Section 2 (50), consider public benefit more than personal benefit, no conflict of interest, sacrifice, have public spirit, be able to separate personal matters from work duties and do not engage in business or be involved in benefits arising from perform their duties.

Therefore, in order to avoid actions that may affect the decision to perform duties or leads to discrimination or cause conflicts of interest. Nanongthoom Subdistrict Municipality is specifying a practice guideline against accepting bribes, gifts, presents or any other benefits (NO GIFT POLICY) "Stop giving, refrain from receiving" by the guideline as follows.

- 1. Do not ask about giving or receiving gifts, souvenirs, presents, or other benefits.
 - 2. Do not give or receive gifts, souvenirs, presents or any other benefits.
- 3. Do not accept or witness any gifts or other benefits with those involved in the work.
- 4. There is no conflict of interest in the work, as well as providing benefits for oneself or others which cause damage to the government or by corruption.
- 5. In the event that a government official under the Nanongthoom Subdistrict Municipality is found to have committed such an offense, the Nanongthoom Subdistrict Municipality will seriously punish the offender.

This announcement shall be informed and strict compliance.
